Subject: French as a Second Language (FSL) Program Providers

This memorandum supersedes any prior direction on the language of instruction or eligible program providers for French as a Second Language (FSL) pre-service programs, FSL as an area of study in initial teacher education programs or FSL Additional Qualification (AQ) or Additional Basic Qualification (ABQ) programs.

An English-language provider prepares candidates to teach The Ontario Curriculum, using curriculum documents written in English, in English-language Boards of Education.

A French-language provider prepares candidates to teach *le curriculum de l'Ontario*, using the *programmes-cadres* written in French, in French-language Boards of Education.

These curricula differ in both content and language.

This memorandum clarifies that FSL pre-service programs, FSL as an area of study in initial teacher education programs and FSL AQ/ABQ programs may only be offered by Englishlanguage providers.

The FSL requirement aligns with the goals and foundation of the FSL curriculum for both teachers and students. The curricula of FSL pre-service programs, FSL as an area of study in initial teacher education programs and FSL AQ/ABQ programs have been developed for, and are intended to be offered by, English-language providers. This English language-specific development reflects the English-language school systems in which The Ontario Curriculum - French as a Second Language is taught.

The FSL pre-service and AQ/ABQ programs covered by this memorandum are set out below:

Pre-Service Programs

Pre-service programs may offer FSL as an area of study that leads to an FSL basic qualification on a certificate of qualification and registration ("certificate"). This FSL

qualification is set out in Schedule A of the Teachers' Qualifications Regulation (O. Reg. 176/10 – "TQR") of the *Ontario College of Teachers Act* ("Act").

The primary/junior division pre-service program with a focus on teaching FSL is set out in the Accreditation of Teacher Education Programs Regulation (O. Reg. 347/02) of the Act. It leads to basic qualifications in the primary and junior divisions and an AQ equivalency that appears on a certificate as FSL Part 1.

AQ/ABQ Programs

Programs leading to FSL qualifications may be offered as a three-session AQ, as set out in Schedule D to the TQR. Programs leading to FSL qualifications may also be offered as a one-session Honour Specialist AQ as set out in Schedule E to the TQR.

Programs leading to FSL qualifications may be offered as a one-session ABQ, as set out in Schedule A to the TQR.
